This is an impressively ripe wine, smoothly textured although with a core of tannins. Rich black fruits are still young with juicy acidity. Coming from one of the top premier cru vineyards in Volnay, it is sure to age well. Drink from 2023.

## Domaine Henri Delagrangre 2017 Les Bertins Premier Cru (Pommard)

Twelve months in barrel have given this wine density as well as structure. It comes from a vineyard south of the village, moving towards the softness of Volnay. Ripe black fruits are still developing and the wine needs time. Drink from 2023.

## Domaine Henri Delagrangé 2017 Vieilles Vignes (Volnay)

Blending old vines from across the Delgrange domaine, this structured wine still shows some wood aging but is full of generous black fruits. Its texture is dense rather than firm, suggesting the wine will age over the medium term. Drink from 2021.

This wine comes from a large premier cru vineyard below the village. Concentrated tannins give structure to generous black-cherry fruits. With acidity and a layer of solid tannins, the wine will age well.
