Pommard Les Bertins 2014

This dense, concentrated red is saturated with black cherry, blackberry, vanilla and toasted spice aromas and flavors. Everything is well-proportioned, but this needs time to come together. Excellent aftertaste. Best from 2019 through 2032. 120 cases made. (Dec 31, 2016)

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Pommard Les Vaumuriens Hauts
2014

A dense, meaty red, offering black cherry, blackberry and iron flavors. The tannins are rustic, yet there is plenty of fruit to match. The finish shows balance and fine length. Best from 2018 through 2025. 300 cases made. (Dec 31, 2016)

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Volnay Champans 2014

Black currant and violet aromas and flavors pick up earth and iron elements as this intense red plays out. Firm and succulent, with a long, fruit- and spice-saturated finish. Best from 2019 through 2030. 120 cases made. (Dec 31, 2016)

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Volnay Vieilles Vignes 2014

A rich, fleshy Volnay, boasting black cherry, black currant and spice flavors, with density and a cushion of fine tannins. Balanced and approachable now, but should be better in a year or two. Best from 2018 through 2027. 650 cases made. (Dec 31, 2016)

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Volnay Clos des Chênes 2014

This is rich, smoothing out with a little air, exhibiting cherry, vanilla and toast aromas and flavors. The tannins are firm and dense, so decant now or age for a few years. Best from 2019 through 2032. 250 cases made. (Dec 31, 2016)

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
